Delhi

New Delhi is the capital of India, and is also the travel hub for northern India. Old Delhi, the capital of Muslim India between the mid-17th and late 19th centuries, is full of formidable mosques, monuments and forts. It is a lively area of colourful bazaars, narrow streets and barely controlled chaos. In contrast, New Delhi, the imperial city created by the British Raj, is composed of spacious, tree-lined avenues and imposing government buildings, and has a sense of order absent in other parts of the city.

Jaipur, popularly known as the Pink City, was founded in 1727 AD by one of the greatest rulers of the Kachhawaha clan, the astronomer king Sawai Jai Singh. The pink color was used at the time of making to create an impression of red sandstone buildings of Mughal cities - and repainted in 1876, during the visit of the Prince of Wales.

Bharatpur

A change of pace as you enter into the tranquil Keoladeo Ghanga Sanctuary famous for rare avian species. Stretching over a 29

sq. km. marshy area it is an ideal terrain for migratory birds.

Fatehpur Sikri

Destination

Fatehpur Sikri is located about 40 km away from Agra and is one of the renowned World Heritage sites by UNESCO. The city was built during the period 1571 to 1585 by great Mughal emperor Akbar.

Famed with one of the Seven Wonders of the World - the Taj Mahal, Agra is one of the most popular tourist destinations in India. Agra Fort is another outstanding Mughul monument that is included in your visit.

Gwalior

The majestic monument, Gwalior Fort was the nucleus of administration of the Tomars. Based on a sandstone hill, in hilly terrain, this fort commands a panoramic view of the fabulous valley below. A massive structure, being the largest one of its kind, the Gwalior fort is a classic example of medieval architecture.

Orchha

Khajuraho

Known to the devout as Kashi, is said to have been founded by Shiva, Lord of the Universe. Situated on the banks of the sacred Ganges, the city has been a centre of learning and civilisation for over 2000 years.


